WHAT? ✓

The Marist Student Leadership Programme empowers you to develop your leadership skills in order to support fellow students and to benefit the wider community.

Over two years, opportunities to develop your leadership qualities are provided through a range of learning experiences, both in everyday school life and in targeted leadership initiatives. These activities encourage you to recognise the contribution you can make as a leader, keeping Marist Values central.

In Year 1, as a Junior Marist Leader you develop your Leadership skills and begin to live out the Marist Values.

In Year 2, as a Senior Marist Leader you take on a mentoring role for new leaders and participate in the facilitation of events.

WHEN? ✓

Marist Leaders carry out activities in their schools throughout the year.

WHO? ✓

- The programme is facilitated by Aisling Demaison - Marist Education, and Alastair Callaghan - Kinharvie Institute.
- Each school has a number of Marist Coordinators who facilitate the Marist Leaders activities and meetings in each school.
- The programme is open to all students in the relevant year group in each school.
- In each calendar year, 10 junior Marist Leader places are available per school.
